## PURPOSE/PHILOSOPHY

A Board member must be conscientious in contributing and helping the Board to fulfill its responsibilities for guiding the university; in defining its mission, planning, and goal setting; protecting and furthering its assets; and being accountable for the ethical conduct of all of its affairs.

## **BYLAW**

Therefore, a member of the Board of Governors of the University of the Fraser Valley shall:

- 1. Act as an Ambassador and advocate for the University of the Fraser Valley.
- 2. Understand the Board's role in policy making and the distinctive roles of the Board, Senate, and Administration.
- 3. Maintain loyalty to the university, not to any part or constituency.
- 4. Maintain respect for the opinions of colleagues and restraint in criticism of colleagues and officers.
- 5. Speak freely at Board meetings, but support policies, programs, and decisions once established.
- 6. Be prudent and use good judgment consistent with accepted standards.
- 7. Recognize the President as the primary spokesperson for the university and the Chair of the Board as the only person authorized to speak for the Board.
- 8. Foster openness and trust among Board members, administration, faculty, staff, students, provincial government, and the public.
- Maintain the highest ethical standards, adhere to conflict of interest guidelines, maintain confidentiality when expected, and support the university's statement on institutional ethics.
- 10. Participate in ongoing Board education and evaluation processes.
