WORK TERMS:

Work terms are full-time 4, 8 or 12 months on a semester basis:

- January - April
- May - August
- September - December

A minimum of 420 paid working hours per semester is required

HIRING AND WORK TERM PROCESS:

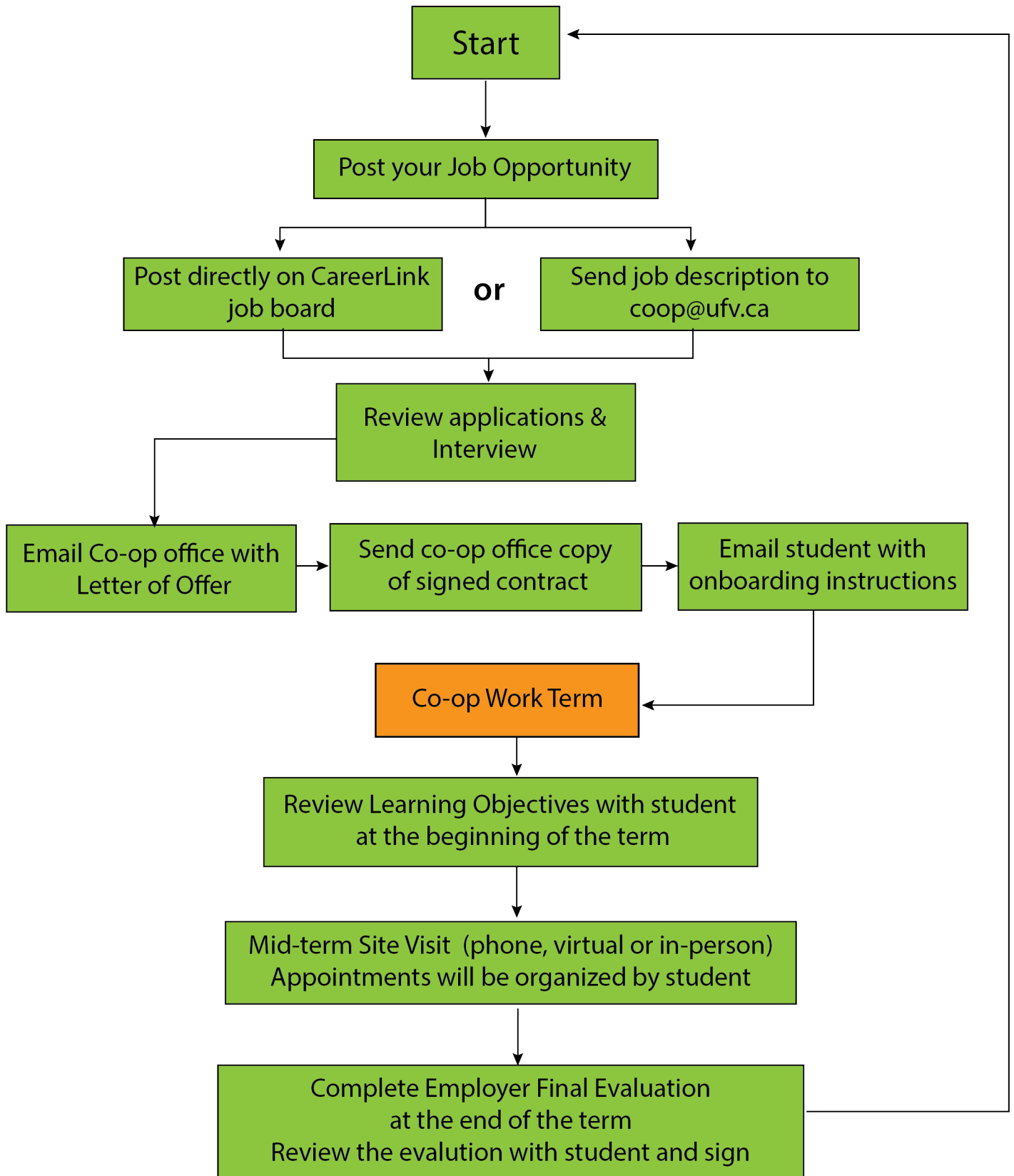
- Post jobs online for free all year round. To access our job board, go to ufv.ca/jobs, click on CareerLink for Employers, and create an account or e-mail coop@ufv.ca with a job posting
- Qualified students apply with cover letters, resumes, and unofficial transcripts, which will be forwarded to you for screening and shortlisting
- Contact the Co-op office with your shortlist of candidates. A Co-op Coordinator can assist you with interview arrangements
- When the interview process is complete and you are ready to hire, contact the Co-op office - we will connect you with the student (if you haven't already done so) to discuss the details of the position
- As a Co-op employer, you set the wage based on the student's skills, year of study, and prior co-op experience
- During the work term, employers provide training, feedback and support to the student
- A Co-op Coordinator will conduct a mid-point site visit to ensure satisfaction and get feedback
- At the end of the term, the employer/supervisor is asked to complete a final Employer Evaluation form
