Full-Time Student Funding

Canada-BC Integrated Student Loan

• Designed to provide additional financial assistance to eligible students enrolled in at least 60% (9 credits, 100-level or higher) of a full-time course load (40% for students with permanent disabilities) at a provincially designated post-secondary school for a minimum study period of 12 weeks with studies leading towards a certificate, diploma, or degree.

• Upon submission of application, grant funding may be awarded based on students' financial need or situation.

Part-Time Student Funding

Part-Time Student Loan Program

• Designed to assist students enrolled in 20% – 59% of a full-time course load at a provincially designated post-secondary school in a program leading to a certificate, diploma, or degree.

• Unlike the Canada-BC Student Loan for full-time studies, the Part-Time Studies student loan does not cover living costs. It allows for tuition, books, supplies, transportation, and unsubsidized childcare up to the funding maximums.

• Upon submission of application, grant funding may be awarded based on students' financial need or situation.

Adult Basic Education Student Assistance Program (ABESAP)

• Students must demonstrate financial need and be enrolling in Upgrading and University Preparation (UUP), English as a Second Language (ESL), or TASK (ASE).

• Grant funding is for direct educational costs: tuition, books, supplies, and childcare up to program limits. Awards are based on 16 weeks of study.
