The University of the Fraser Valley is a place of principled people. To guide the ethical conduct of its members and to fulfill its mandate, vision, mission, and values, and Integrated Strategic Plan and related plans, the Board of Governors believes it is important for the University to articulate its ethical standards.

Members of the Board of Governors, employees, and students of the university are expected to demonstrate high standards of personal and professional conduct to maintain public confidence in their actions and in the university.

The President brings to the attention of the Board any ethical issues or concerns involving a significant risk to the University including, but not limited to, the safety and health of students, employees, and visitors; the quality of academic performance; the effectiveness of leadership; and the protection of its assets and property or to its image and reputation.
