 - C+ (67%) minimum in English 12
 - C+ (67%) minimum Pre-calculus 11
 - If you are missing one or both of the requirements, you have the option of <u>taking an assessment test or an upgrading course</u> at UFV.
 - See the <u>prerequisites</u> to ENGL 105 and MATH 140 for upgrading and assessment test options.

Bachelor of Business Administration Admission Requirements

- For students entering from high school:
 - C+ (67%) minimum in English 12
 - C+ (67%) minimum Pre-calculus 12
 - B (73%) minimum in an <u>approved</u> grade 12 course
 - If you are missing the math or English requirements, you have the option of <u>taking an assessment</u> <u>test or an upgrading course</u> at UFV.
 - See the <u>prerequisites</u> to ENGL 105 and MATH 141 for upgrading and assessment test options.

How Do I Manage My Courses?


Courses can be 3, 4, or 5 credits.

For every credit, plan for 2 to 3 hours of coursework outside of class.

Budget about 12 hours per week for each 3 credit class.

Online courses require more independent study.

Getting Ready to Attend Class Tips



Pay attention to the campus code; sections are coded AB for Abbotsford, CH for CEP campus, and ON for online

Attend the first day of class for in-person classes or login to myClass by the deadline (published in the Timetable)

- Operation System: Windows 10 or masOC Catalina (10.15)
- Processor: Intel i5 or AMD Ryzen 5 (or higher)

BROWSER

- Latest version of Chrome
 - Check your browser version

INTERNET

- ☐ Fast & stable internet connection:
- Local: 100 mbps download & 10 mbps upload

→ Test Speed (local servers)

Remote: 50 mbps download & 5mbps upload

EQUIPMENT

- USB Headset & Mic: Microsoft LX-300 or Logitech H340 or better
 - → Test your microphone
 - → Test your sound
- □ Webcam: Logitech C170 or better
 - → Test your webcam
- Set headset as default device for speaker and microphone.

BEFORE ONLINE SESSION

- Choose a quiet area with few distractions.
- Check the lighting and make sure you're not sitting in the shadows.
- If using Wi-Fi, ask the other users in your residence to limit heavy internet use during your online class.
- Restart computer & close all other programs.
- If necessary, <u>clear Chrome's cache</u> & restart browser.

DURING ONLINE SESSION


- Mute your mic and then un-mute it only when you need to talk


