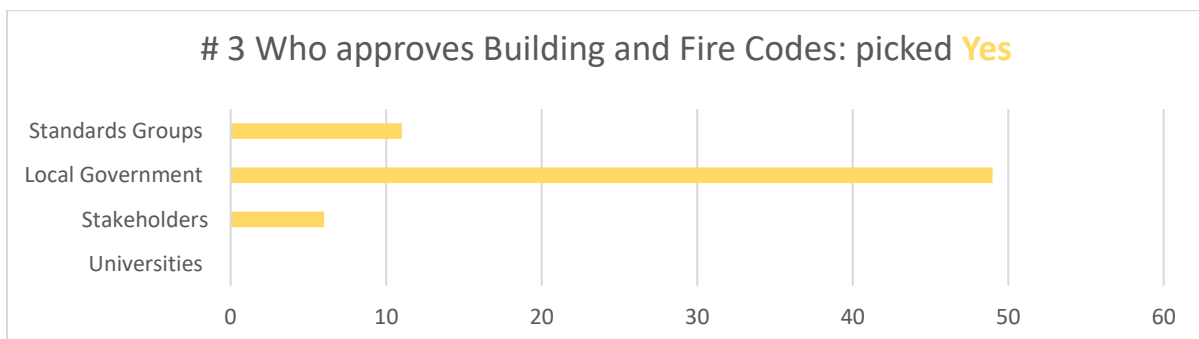
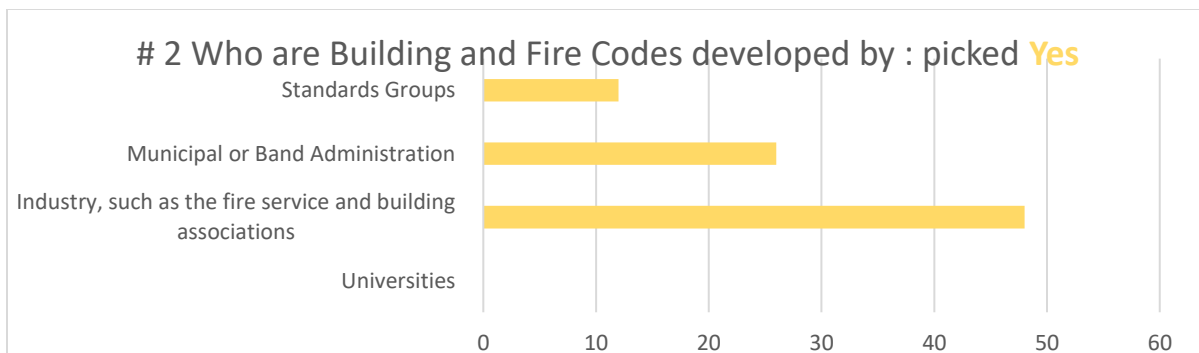
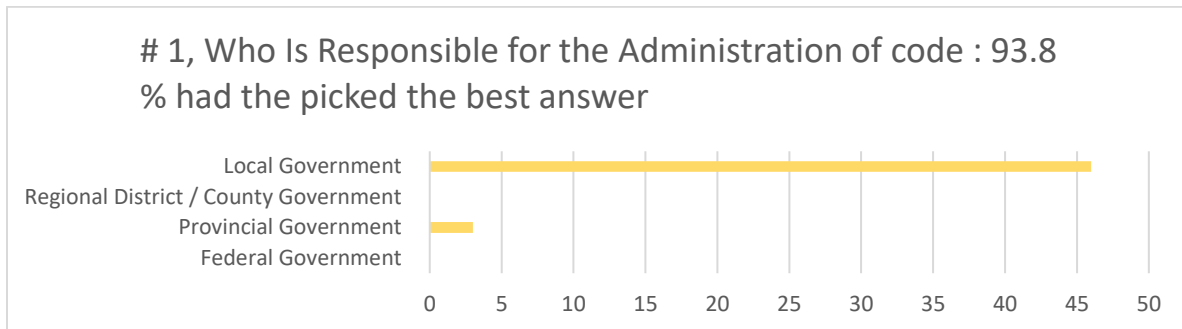


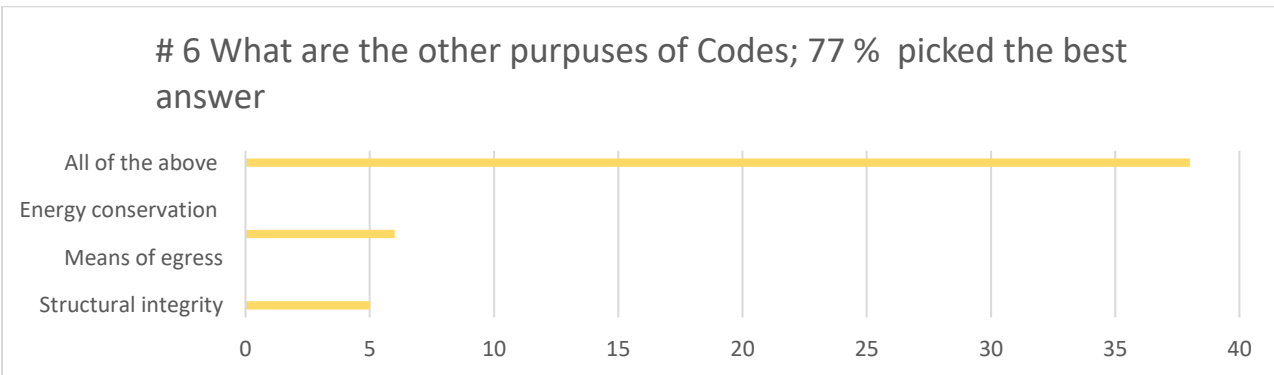
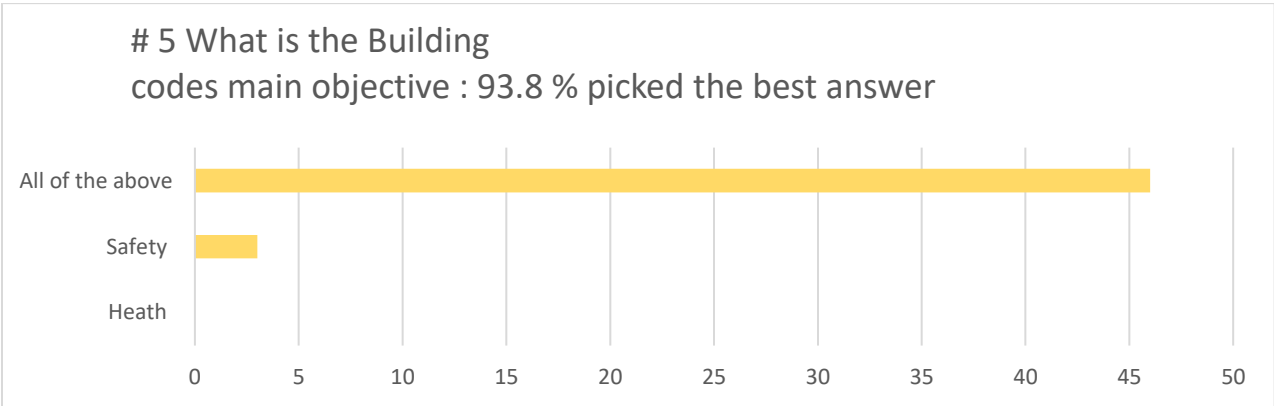
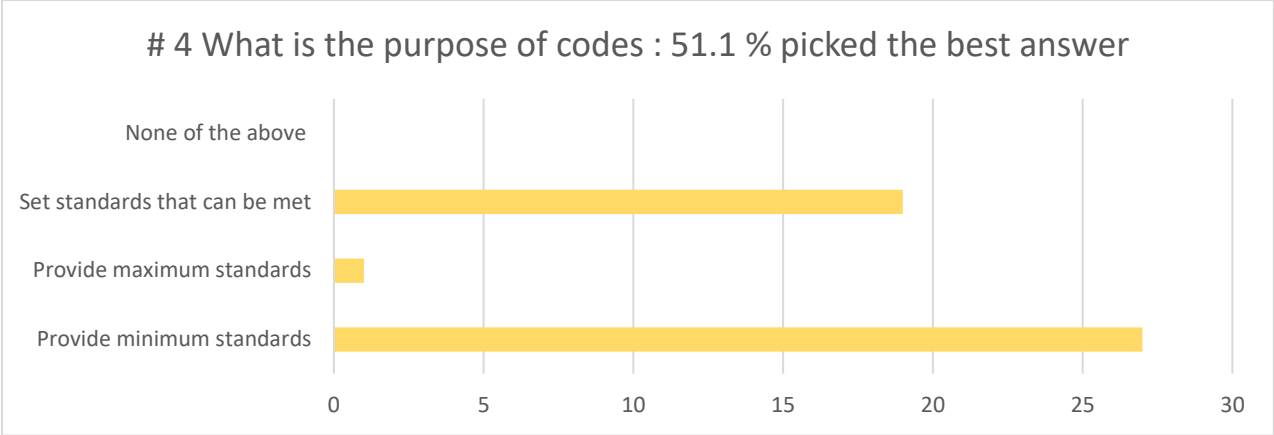
Codes and Standards – What We heard

This survey has been designed to assess the basic knowledge that an indigenous person living on reserve may have about building codes and standards in Canada.

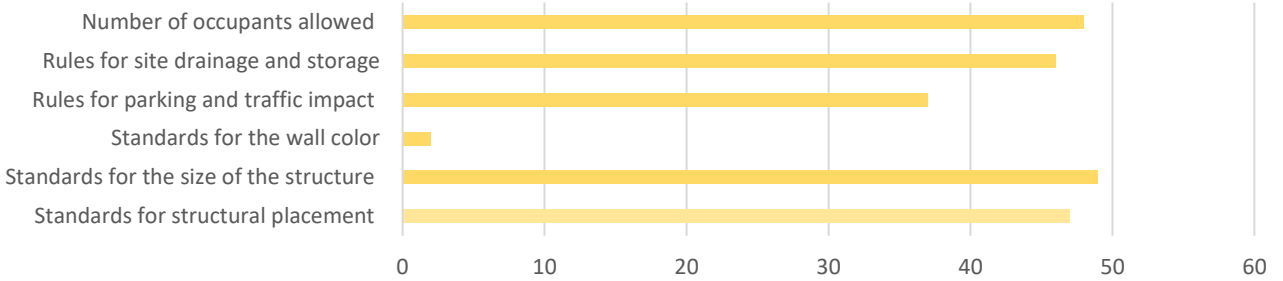

The following is a summary of responses intended to be informative but not statistically representative.

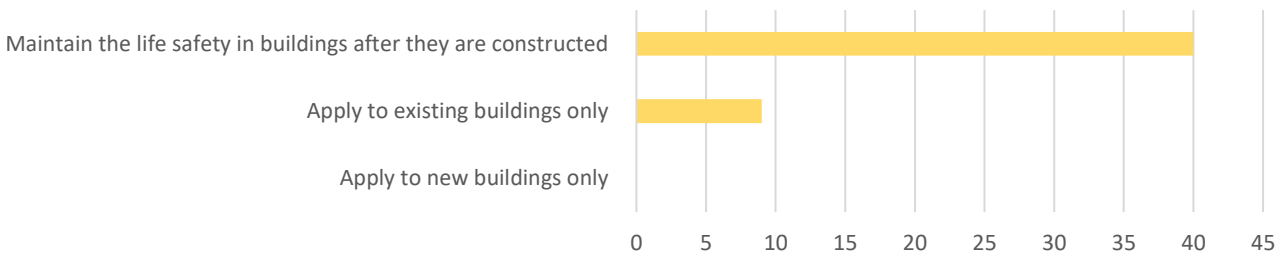




7 What Rule and Standards do Building Codes generally include: picked **Yes**
