Nursing Unit Clerk students are required to provide a current record of their immunizations prior to entering a hospital for practicum. On the following chart, please indicate the year you had the vaccine/disease and **have your doctor verify where indicated (initials or signature)**.

Vaccine/Disease	Year	Doctor's Verification	Information
Diphtheria:			Vaccine must have been given within last 10 years.
Tetanus:			Same as for Diphtheria.
Polio:			Polio-Salk series as a child (Sabin, oral, 3)
Pertussis:			Current vaccination required. (Given in grade 9)
Measles:			If you've had the disease/vaccine, nothing further is required.
Mumps:			Same as for measles
Flu Shot:			This vaccination must be done 2 weeks before practicum start date. Fraser Health Authority requires all practicum students to have a current influenza vaccination in order to be placed at a hospital. You must carry your immunization record with you at all times while on practicum.

Rubella: Your program requires you to have immunity to Rubella. If you cannot provide appropriate documentation, a blood test must be done to determine immunity. If the results show an insufficient titre, the applicant must receive the vaccine. **Please attach photo copy of lab results.**

***Hepatitis B:** If you have received this immunization, please indicate dates below. If you have not received it, you should complete the cycle prior to entering the practicum placement.

Please attach documentation indicating dates taken. Note: Hepatitis B takes up to 9 months to complete
