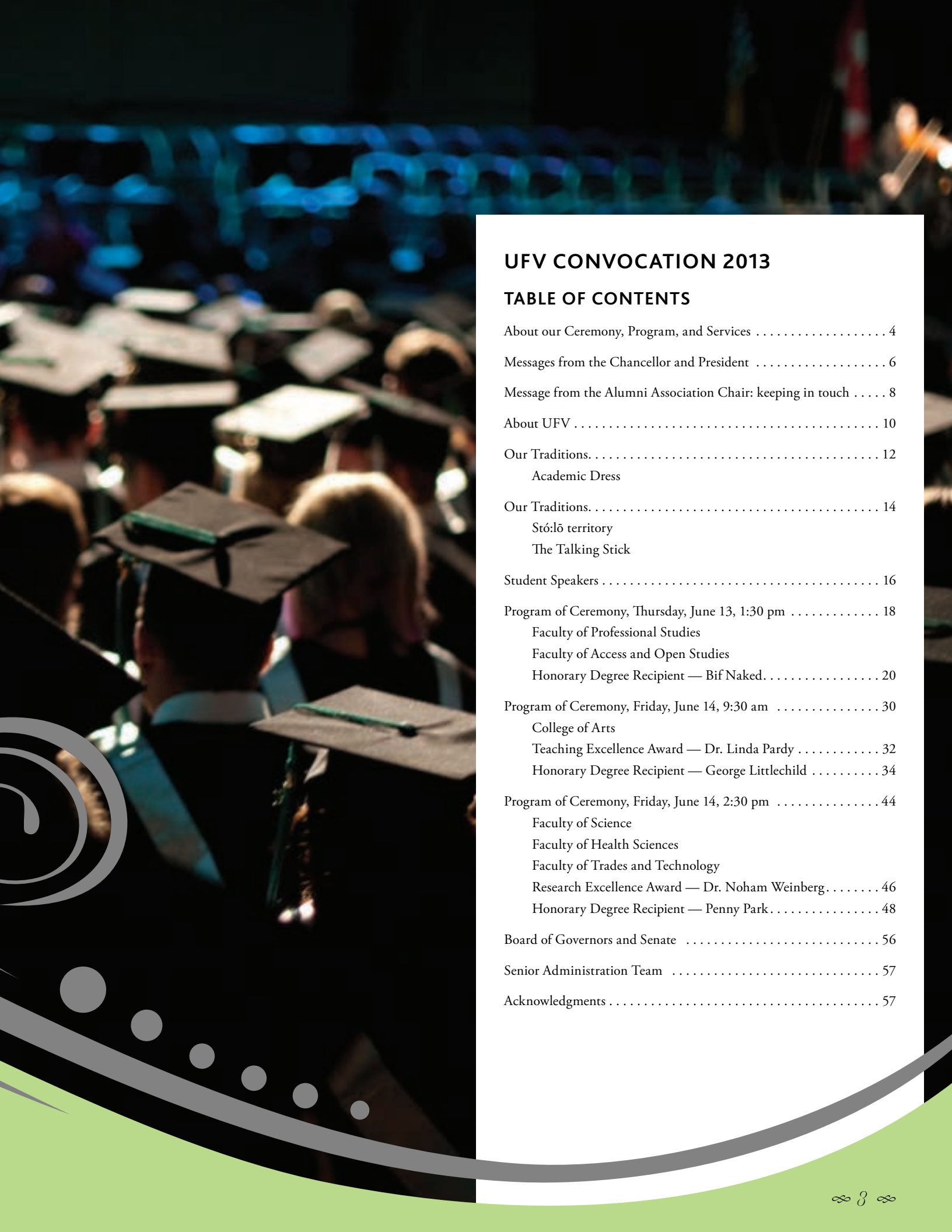

STUDENT RECOGNITION — WHAT THE SYMBOLS MEAN

Dean's List of Distinguished Students (*)

The Deans' List recognizes those university students who have maintained a high academic standard throughout their course of studies. To be eligible for the Deans' List, a student must:

- (a) have successfully completed at least fifteen credits in a semester with a semester grade point average of at least 3.5; or
- (b) have a documented permanent disability, which affects his/her ability to participate in full-time studies and have successfully completed at least nine credits in a semester with a semester grade point average of at least 3.5; or
- (c) have completed all the program graduation requirements with a grade point average of at least 3.5 based on the credits earned while in the program or the previous five years, whichever is shorter, with a semester GPA of at least 3.0 in the most recent semester in which at least one graded course was completed; or
- (d) be in an entry-level Trades program and have an average of 90% or higher in all courses.

We are proud to recognize the special achievements of these students, denoted with the * symbol.

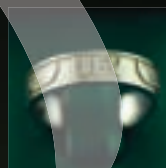

ABOUT UFV

FRASER VALLEY ORIGINS — FRASER VALLEY FOCUS

In 1974, after years of active campaigning by Fraser Valley citizens, Fraser Valley College (FVC) was established in Chilliwack and Abbotsford, with smaller centres in Mission, Hope, and Agassiz. In the early years, students gathered in church basements, local schools, and storefronts. The first buildings dedicated to FVC use opened at Marshall Road in Abbotsford and Yale Road in Chilliwack in the mid-1970s. The first permanent campus opened in 1983 on King Road in Abbotsford.

FVC became the University College of the Fraser Valley (UCFV) in 1991, following another tremendous round of community support, and launched its first four-year bachelor's degree programs in September 1992. More degrees were launched each year for several years. New facilities opened in Chilliwack in 1995 and in Mission the following year (as part of the Heritage Park Centre).

In April 2008, the provincial government announced university status for UFV, following years of active lobbying by the communities of the Fraser Valley. The University of the Fraser Valley (UFV) began operations under its new name on September 1, 2008.

The new Canada Education Park campus in Chilliwack opened for classes in September 2012. It joins the state-of-the-art Trades and Technology Centre on Tyson Road.

TODAY

In 2013, UFV is a fully accredited, public university that enrolls over 16,000 students per year. UFV has campuses and locations in Abbotsford, Chilliwack, Mission, and Hope, and international partnerships across the globe. Over 2,000 students graduate from UFV every year to join the ranks of the over 30,000 alumni.

The university now offers more than 100 programs, including two master's degrees, 15 bachelor's degrees, majors, minors, and extended minors, diplomas and certificates in more than 30 subject areas, and more than a dozen trades and technology programs.

As it grows, the university will continue to offer programming that addresses regional needs, while maintaining the strong commitment to teaching excellence that has resulted in outstanding student satisfaction rates.

It is UFV's vision to provide the best undergraduate education in Canada and to be a leader of the social, cultural, economic, and environmentally-responsible development of the Fraser Valley. OUR TRADITIONS

ACADEMIC DRESS

Traditional academic regalia consists of a gown, hood, and a mortarboard or cap and tassel. The wearing of robes became common in the middle ages. In monasteries and universities of the time, scholars wore the same long closed gowns as other medieval men. By the time the University of Cambridge was founded in the early thirteenth century, doctors in law and music were permitted to wear gowns in scarlet, purple, and red. Over time, garments and colours came to identify their university. Regalia colours often matched those of the university patron, or the colours of the city in which the university was located.

At UFV, regalia incorporate the university's rich green colours. There are vee-stoles for diploma and certificate graduates, while bachelor program graduates wear degree hoods. The coloured binding on the edge of the degree hoods represents the particular faculty from which a student is graduating. UFV hood colours are:

- White — Arts
- Silver — Health Sciences
- Dark green — Professional Studies
- Pale green — Science
- Royal blue velvet — Honorary degree.

The addition of red cord denotes a master's degree.





OUR TRADITIONS

STÓ:LŌ TERRITORY

UFV strives to be a place of learning that recognizes, respects and includes indigenous ways of knowing. Our Fraser Valley locations are in the traditional territory of the Stó:lō peoples.

THE GATHERING PLACE

UFV opened the Gathering Place at the Chilliwack campus at Canada Education Park in 2012. This beautiful facility is a key resource for Aboriginal Access services, the community, and others at UFV.

THE TALKING STICK

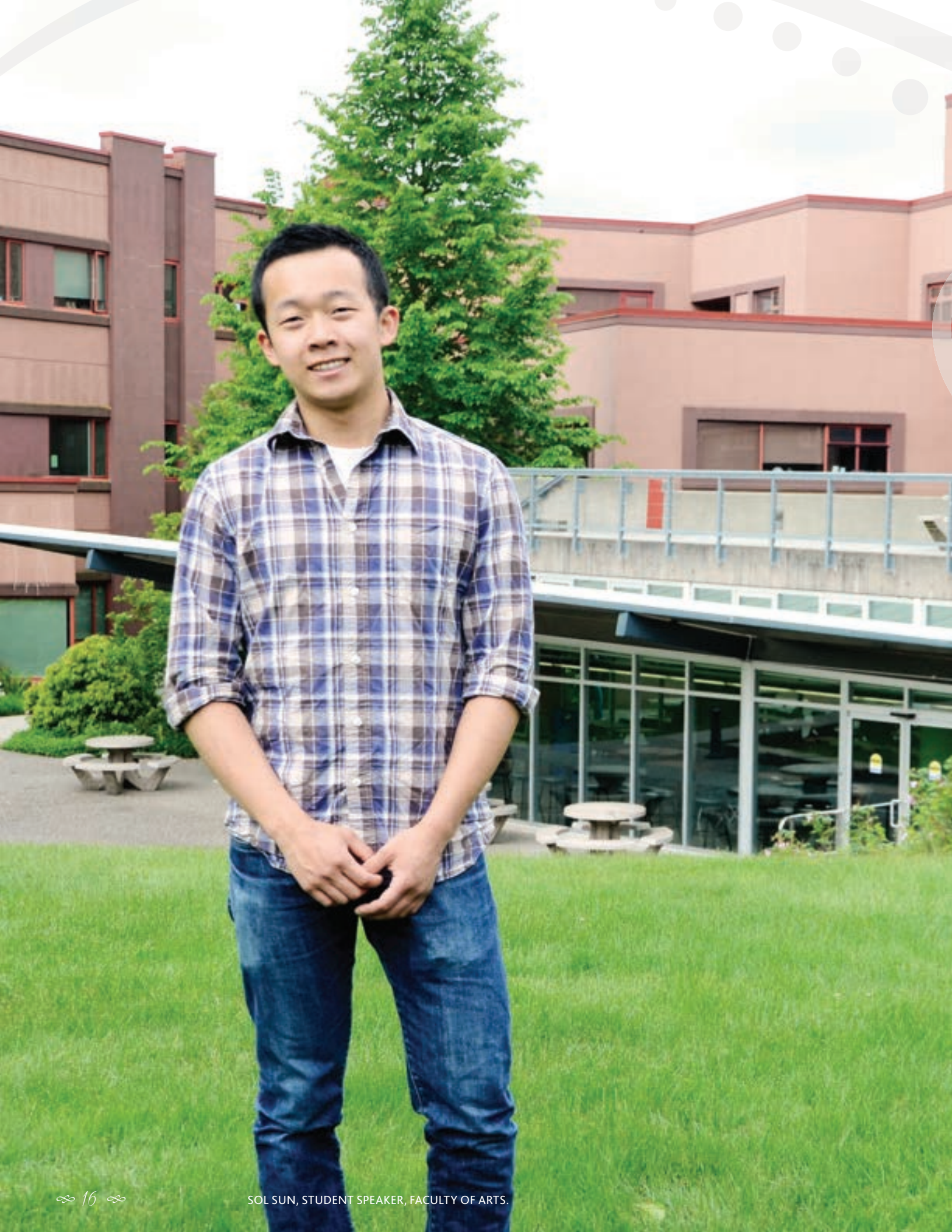
The Talking Stick is a gift from the Stó:lō people to UFV, honouring all aboriginal people. The Talking Stick leads the procession into Convocation and the recession after the ceremony.

The figures on the Talking Stick being used at UFV's Convocation are a wolf and a thunderbird. The wolf is symbolic of "the teacher" in Stó:lō territory while the thunderbird represents the highest level of knowledge.

Most universities in the Commonwealth have a ceremonial mace, which accompanies the convocation ceremonies.

It is the staff of office, representing official authority (such as the Speaker of the House of Commons).

UFV uses the Talking Stick rather than a mace for this purpose, thus bringing together a partnership between aboriginal and university traditions.



STUDENT SPEAKERS

Each year UFV departments nominate students to present the graduand address at each convocation ceremony. It is a great honour to be selected to represent the graduands of 2012-2013. We congratulate the following student speakers:

LAURIE SCHULZ, CHILLIWACK

Faculty of Professional Studies, Master of Social Work

Laurie Schulz may be adding a third credential after her name, but that doesn't mean she's done learning.

Laurie is graduating with the first cohort of graduates from the Master of Social Work program at UFV. She previously earned a Social Services diploma and Bachelor of Social Work degree at the university, first starting as a UFV student in 2002.

She juggled many responsibilities while pursuing her master's degree, including her job as a counsellor with Impact Youth Substance Use Services, her time with her six-year-old daughter, and commuting between her home in Chilliwack and her work and studies in Abbotsford. It was worth it, she says. "I was at a place where I wanted to infuse more meaning into my work and to engage on a higher level. It was quite a challenge personally and academically, but I gleaned a lot from it. I did a huge amount of learning on a personal level through this experience."

Laurie has said that she never imagined herself completing graduate work, and that she has surpassed her own expectations in doing so. She considers UFV her "home base", and credits the university for her professional and personal development.

Laurie says that on her educational journey she tried to be mindful of not getting overwhelmed by what she was "doing" but rather focused on who she was "being" and "becoming."

"We should all recognize that beyond what we do in our jobs, careers, and studies, it is important to understand, appreciate, and grow as people, as it's this that will determine how effective and successful we'll be.

I'd like to challenge us to think beyond what we will now go 'do'... and deeply consider who we will go 'be' as we travel the road ahead."

SOL SUN, ABBOTSFORD

College of Arts, Bachelor of Arts, Honours Psychology

When Sol Sun used to tell his friends that he was studying psychology at university, they would immediately ask him to analyze their dreams.

But there's much more to psychology than that.

Sol's specialty is the study of memory, and he has been working for several years on projects in UFV's psychology lab.

"Studying memory has changed the way I look at life," he says. "Once you really get into studying it you begin to realize just how fallible your memory is and you don't trust it as much."

His particular area of focus was how people recognize faces and residual memory — how someone recognizes stimuli in an environment that they believe they have seen before.

He is grateful for the hands-on research opportunities he got at UFV.

"I heard there were good opportunities for research here. My friends at the bigger schools say they don't get the same opportunities. There are bigger labs there, but much smaller roles for undergraduates. Here you can design a study and follow it through to the end."

Sol's goal is to attain a PhD and become a researcher in the field of cognitive psychology/neuroscience. He will be attending graduate school at the University of Toronto in September. He says that conducting research in the UFV psychology lab under the supervision of Dr. Andrea Hughes was absolutely critical to both gaining acceptance into graduate school, and acquiring the necessary skills to be successful in the future.

DEREK FROESE, ABBOTSFORD

Faculty of Science, Bachelor of Computer Information Systems, Systems and Networking concentration

If you want to make the most of your time at university, don't just go to class and then go home. There's a whole other dimension to the UFV experience that can turbocharge your time here and send you on your way with leadership skills, lasting relationships, the satisfaction of having contributed while you were here, and an enhanced resume. That's the advice in a nutshell from Abbotsford's Derek Froese.

Yes, Derek is graduating with the skills and knowledge gleaned from five years of computing studies, but he's also taking with him experienced gained from being president of the Computer Information Systems Student Association (CISSA) and a general leader on campus.

Through CISSA, he and other students raised money for Child's Play, an organization that provides pediatric wards with video games to help young patients pass the long and tedious hours in hospital.

Working together with the leaders of the other science student associations, he helped launch the Big Bang, a semester-ending party that has morphed into the largest event on campus by its second year.

Along the way he also completed his degree, got to know his instructors and enjoyed the small-class atmosphere, and completed some co-op education work terms, including two within the prison system.

This summer he's working for Kerkhoff Technologies in Chilliwack, run by UFV alumnus Wim Kerkhoff, which just goes to show that those UFV connections come in handy.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

DOCTOR OF LETTERS

BIF NAKED

Originally named Beth Torbert, Naked is a Juno-nominated, multi-platinum-record selling Canadian singer-songwriter, actress, television host and motivational speaker. She has toured Canada, the United States, and Europe as a headlining act and speaker.

She notes that she can finally show a university degree (albeit an honorary one) to her parents and feel some validation for the non-traditional path she chose in life.

“I was enrolled in performing arts studies in Manitoba before my music career took off. My parents have always wished that I’d continued my studies. Being recognized in this way will help explain better to them what my life’s work has been about.”

Mostly, it’s been about self-expression, whether through the in-your-face music over the course of five studio albums released from 1995 to 2009, or her poetry and paintings, or her new career as a motivational speaker.

“The number-one thing I have tried to do is express myself, whether it’s in song, speaking, or painting,” she says. “What I say is always a reflection of my perception of life. We all have the same experiences; there’s nothing we do that our neighbour hasn’t experienced, so we can all relate. Whatever I say or sing, someone can somehow identify with it. My songs are a creative communication form. They make these feelings and experiences accessible.

“As for my speaking career, I talk like I sing. My theme is always the same — be true to who you are. Always! I was the class clown who talked too much and that is still who I am.”

The speaking career came about when she was asked to do a few talks based on her experiences as a young woman battling breast cancer. She was diagnosed with cancer in 2008 at the age of 36 and underwent a lumpectomy, an ovariectomy, radiation, and chemotherapy. She also underwent heart surgery in 2012.

She now speaks to women’s organizations, cancer survivors, medical researchers, women in business, and people starting their careers.

To say breast cancer changed her life would be an understatement.

“It changed my life completely! If it hadn’t happened I wouldn’t have been pulled off my tour and the general crazy train life I was leading, on the road all the time, hosting two martial arts shows. If I hadn’t had to go into cancer treatment, I would never have discovered how much I love volunteering in the health care system, working with other people with cancer.”

Naked’s honorary degree is in recognition of her outstanding contribution to the performing arts, her courage in dealing with a number of personal challenges, and especially for her dedicated, inspirational, and life-changing work with young women.

TEACHING EXCELLENCE AWARD

DR. LINDA PARDY

To do Dr. Linda Pardy's Teaching Excellence award justice, you need a rainy Saturday morning. That's how long it takes to go through the binder of recommendation letters collected on behalf of the Abbotsford-based UFV communications instructor for the nomination process.

Pardy's nomination was supported by countless students from a range of disciplines who have taken one — or often several — of her communication courses at UFV.

There are too many to quote them all, but this statement from one of her Communications 345 students summarizes their collective feelings well:

"At the end of our course, Linda was thanking us for being such great students. This began a domino effect and several students spoke up thanking Linda and describing how much we appreciate teachers like her. In all my years of university I have never seen so many students genuinely thanking an instructor. We need more teachers like Linda. Her passion for teaching and her positive attitude are contagious, and create an encouraging learning atmosphere. I will never forget my learning experience with Linda, and I hope you can see how much she deserves this award."

Many of the students who are Pardy's biggest fans are those who fall into the 'non-traditional' student category: older students, part-time learners, people juggling careers and families while pursuing courses. That should be no surprise: Pardy was a non-traditional student herself when she completed her Bachelor of Arts in Adult Education degree at UFV. She then went on to earn a master's degree and a doctorate in education, with a specialty in workplace learning, at the University of Calgary while raising a family and launching her teaching career at UFV.

And before all that she'd already put in over 20 years on the support and administrative side at Kwantlen University, moving up the ranks to director of student services through stints in cooperative education, financial aid, student services, and community and corporate education. So she came to teaching with a strong understanding of the challenges that students face outside of the classroom.

"Coming from a student services background, I have a somewhat unconventional way of teaching — with more of an emphasis on workshops and presentations than lectures," she notes.

Many of her courses end with a project rather than a final exam, since she's trying to simulate the workplace for her students. In some of her upper-level classes, these can include real-life projects such as organizing trade expos or board meetings. She is also experimenting with "flipped" classes, in which all the lectures are posted online and classroom time is dedicated entirely to working directly with the students on their projects.

"The only way we are going to solve all the 'big world' issues facing humanity is for people and groups to work together, so students might as well get used to it while they are at university," she says.

She finds that this approach stimulates and engages her students.

"Students need this engagement both inside and outside the classroom in order to succeed at university," she says, adding that she brings her 'student services self' into the classroom as an instructor.

Her doctoral research, involved following four unconventional students who were 'at risk' of not completing university, also informs her teaching style.

"Some faculty members are averse to reaching out to students at risk. They just assume that they are not going to succeed. But I know that there are students with extreme barriers who do graduate. And the majority of our students are non-traditional in some form. At the very least many are the first ever in their families to attend university. People with a student services focus and background know that these non-traditional students can succeed. In order to do so, they need to feel ready, they need to feel welcome in the classroom, they need to have their prior knowledge respected, and they need a flexible, understanding university supporting them."

Pardy is a busy woman. In addition to teaching university classes, she participates on many UFV committees, is involved in designing new courses, teaches instructional skills workshops, facilitates retreats, and generally embraces being part of the UFV community.

As for receiving the award, she says it's both a humbling and an overwhelming experience.

"Just the nomination process itself is a gift, to see all the student letters written in support of me. You never know when you take a chance to do something innovative, if it will have the impact you hope it does, so to see what the students say in those letters is very affirming".

GEORGE LITTLECHILD

Prolific and colourful. Vibrant artworks infused with Aboriginal influence but with his own contemporary twist. When you see George Littlechild's work you won't soon forget it.

The Cree artist, originally from Alberta but now living in British Columbia, has built both a strong reputation and a huge catalog of work over the 25 years he's been pursuing his muse since graduating with a Bachelor of Fine Arts from the Nova Scotia School of Art and Design.

Soon he will have another credential to hang on his wall: an honorary Doctor of Literature degree from the University of the Fraser Valley.

Littlechild has been compelled to create since he was a literally a 'little child'.

"My foster mother saw that I had a talent at a very young age. She was encouraging, loving... She saw the gift in me," recalls Littlechild on his website biography. "Scribblers were filled; art lessons began at an early age."

Even though he was artistic from birth, he credits two women for setting him on to the path of being a professional artist: his foster mother for seeing his talent and supporting it with art lessons, and a co-worker at a rehab facility when he was in his 20s who gave him the kick in the pants he needed when she said: "Why aren't you doing art? You've got to get to art school!"

Littlechild didn't grow up with any awareness of his culture or heritage, yet when he started to create art, something inside him compelled him to use the bright vibrant colours of the Cree people from whom he was descended.

"I have an innate blood memory of my culture, it seems. I was born using those colours. As soon as I could grab crayons, those were the colours I gravitated to."

"My art is charged with energy and color, vibrant, magical, and thus enabling the soul to travel. I envision, I rely on the intuitive, the spiritual, the emotional. To tell stories through my art. I am a storyteller, a visualist. A conveyer of messages," he says in the artistic statement on his website.

Part of a large-scale scoop of aboriginal children from their home communities into white adoptive or foster families in the 1950s and '60s, it wasn't until his he was in his twenties that he reconnected with the Hobbema community that his birth family came from, and met aunts and uncles, and siblings he never knew he had. Unfortunately, his birth parents had died before he could meet them.

As his cultural and political awareness grew, his art evolved to reflect his changing consciousness.

"We talk about Idle No More these days, but I've never been idle," he jokes. "I've been thinking about and creating around these issues for years and years. I've always believed in being proactive and making changes for the better of the planet. I've been granted this gift of artistic ability and I believe in using it in the right way."

If I were asked what kind of art I create; I would answer by saying that it is art that speaks from the heart, the social and the political," he notes.

Littlechild has exhibited around the world, and had numerous solo and group exhibitions as he generated hundreds of works of art, many of which have been snapped up by public and private collections. His books and art have won numerous awards and scholarships.

This is Littlechild's introductory comment in his book *This Land Is My Land*: "In Indian Country we are reviving our culture and traditions. Working as an artist is my way of healing the pain of the past and helping the next generation of Indian people. My goal is to heighten awareness of the history and experience of Native Peoples of the Americas and to promote understanding among all peoples."

Along with being true to his aboriginal heritage, Littlechild also believes in living with a positive attitude.

"Life has its ups and downs. But everyone should do what they believe in, and believe in what they do. There will always be downfalls, but eventually it gets easier."

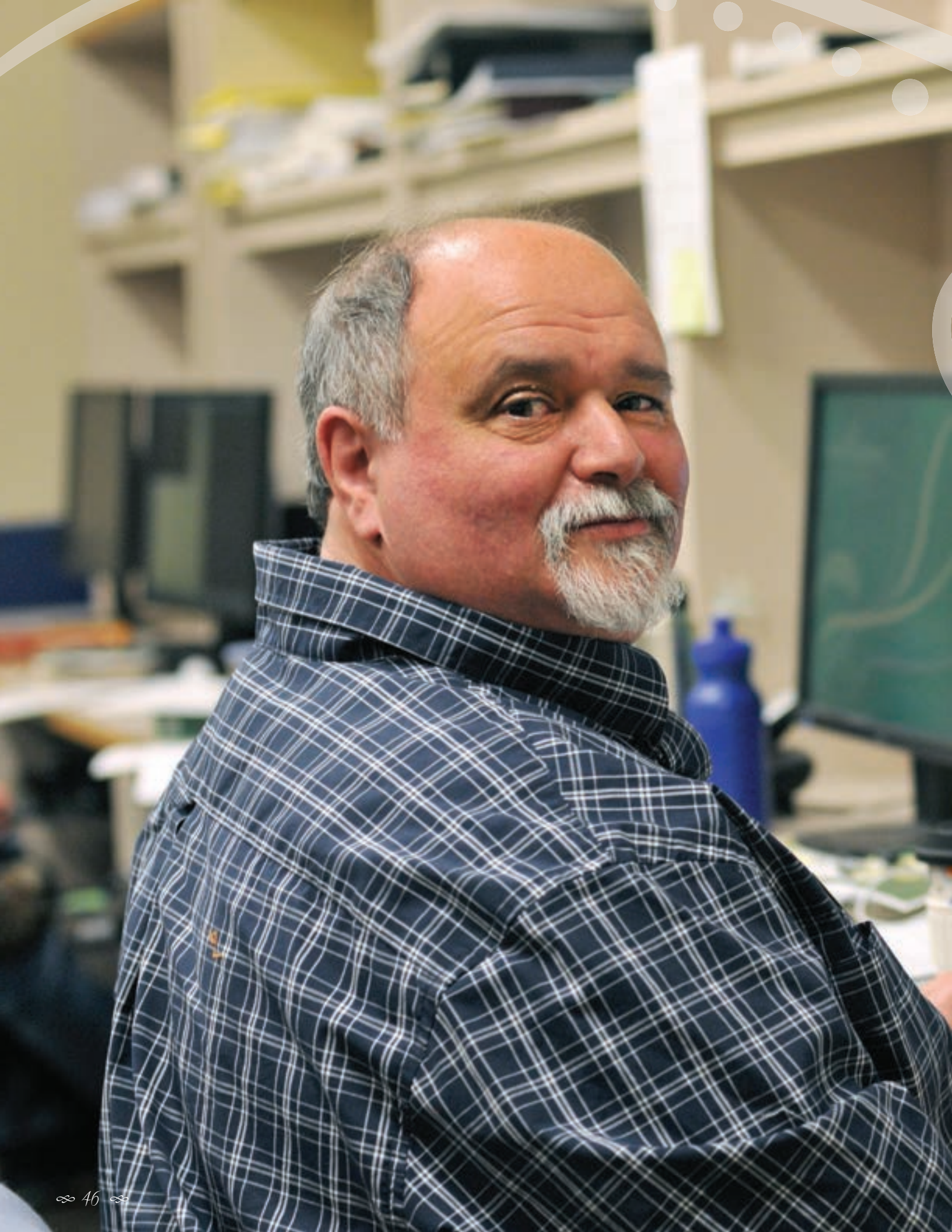

RESEARCH EXCELLENCE AWARD

DR. NOHAM WEINBERG

Research brings great joy to UFV chemist Noham Weinberg.

“For, me, it is like drinking clean water fresh from the source! And having students working with you, seeing them grow into independent researchers, is an even greater joy. It is what drives me. Their enthusiasm is contagious!”

“I like teaching in a classroom setting but this is a completely different experience. Some students are rather timid coming into the research lab because they haven't done research before. Eradicating their fear, teaching them to form their own opinions and to defend these opinions, even if they disagree with mine, is very satisfying.”

In recognition of his dedication to research, his mentorship of many UFV students, and his international reputation in the field of computational chemistry and molecular modeling, Weinberg has been named the 2013 recipient of the UFV Research Excellence award.

Because of the dedication of faculty members like Weinberg who pursue their research interests in addition to their teaching duties, undergraduates at UFV get research experience that they wouldn't get anywhere else.

“With some experience, our undergraduates can do the work that would be done by graduate students at other research-intensive universities.”

Weinberg runs the Molecular Modeling Lab at UFV, where he and his protégés practice a ‘what if’ type of theoretical research. Instead of using actual chemicals, equipment, and test tubes, they use computers to carry out simulated cyber-chemistry experiments using sophisticated software, providing outputs that match results of real experiments.

This is important because, in some cases, carrying out the experiment in the real world would take millions of years, or need extreme conditions, or be prohibitively expensive.

“Computer-simulated models can be an extremely useful substitute for experiments,” notes Weinberg. “For instance, we can screen molecules to see whether or not they would be useful as new antibiotics, and reduce the enormous number of possibilities to a manageable number of promising candidates before committing to the actual experimental trial.”

Molecular modeling is an interdisciplinary field where computers and numerical methods of applied mathematics are used to solve precise and approximate physical models of atomic, molecular, and supra-molecular systems of interest in physics, chemistry, biology, material sciences, and geosciences. With advancement of computer technology, the accuracy of its predictions reaches the level comparable to experimental and, as a result, molecular modeling complements and increasingly replaces often costly and dangerous experimental work.

The UFV Molecular Modeling Lab was created in 2001 and since then has hosted approximately 50 undergraduate students from various departments, including chemistry, biology, physics, math, and computing. These students worked on various interdisciplinary projects and collectively have received six NSERC post-graduate scholarships, 15 NSERC undergraduate student research awards, and 16 UFV undergraduate research excellence awards. A total of 32 of them presented their results at national and international conferences and 22 co-authored papers published in refereed journals.

Weinberg has watched with pride as his students have gone on to graduate school, medical school, and teaching careers. And his students have been very grateful for his support.

“Being able to work alongside Noham in real scientific research has set up a foundation for my future education, and inspired me to pursue research further in graduate school,” noted Jason Ho, a physics honours student and president of the Physics Student Association. “He provides an opportunity for students from a wide range of disciplines to engage in real scientific research and develop skills that cannot be easily learned in a classroom. Although his passion is research, his heart is in teaching, and through that combination he has touched the lives and educations of many students.”

As for how he feels about receiving the Research Excellence award, Weinberg says it's an honour.

“I am thrilled and humbled. There are so many people deserving of such an honour at UFV and I am very proud to be part of this group.”

PENNY PARK

Saying Penny Park's work is sometimes out of this world might seem clichéd.

But it's true — and Canada's better because of it.

As a child, Park wanted to be either a journalist or veterinarian. After studying linguistics at the University of New Brunswick (and taking a turn at the university's radio station), the world of cats and dogs kept calling, so she headed to the University of Guelph, graduating with a BSc (honours) in biology.

But instead of caring for animals, Park's passions were put to good use as producer and senior producer with *Quirks and Quarks*, the award-winning weekly science program on CBC Radio.

Following that, she worked for the Discovery Channel, helping develop the show *Daily Planet*, the world's first nightly TV magazine show about science and technology.

Sitting through board meetings with other properties owned by Discovery's parent company Bell Media (ranging from the *Globe and Mail* to TSN), Park recognized the importance of providing accurate information across the wide spectrum of categories touched by science.

Which includes, basically, everything.

Unfortunately, with more being asked of fewer journalists, the quality of reporting wasn't what many felt the Canadian public deserved.

"Today it's a 24/7 news cycle," Park says.

"There's less time to report on increasingly complex stories, many of which have science at their core — and yet most journalists come from a political science or arts background with little knowledge of science and how science is done."

So in 2010 she changed careers again, becoming executive director of the newly minted Science Media Centre of Canada, a non-profit charitable organization with a variety of services geared to ensure Canadians receive better information and reporting.

"Journalists are increasingly under the gun," she says, pointing out how some cover city hall in the morning before switching gears, and beats, to the oil sands, fisheries, climate change, concussions, or the components of a hockey stick — all of which are related to science.

To help, the SMCC finds experts to talk on a one-on-one basis in addition to providing weekly e-mail alerts that highlight Canadian stories and offering regular webinars.

Funding comes from universities, research institutions, governments, granting councils and other avenues, though no more than 10 per cent can be provided by any one organization to ensure the SMC continues to operate — and continues to be perceived as operating — as an unbiased organization.

"Being able to communicate effectively and tell stories to help people understand difficult matters is essential," Park says.

The Montreal native now living in Toronto is ecstatic to be receiving an Honorary Doctor of Letters degree from the University of the Fraser Valley.

"I'm deeply honoured and truly appreciative of this recognition, not just for myself but for the SMCC and what we do. Ultimately more informed journalism contributes to a well informed public, and a well informed public is essential to a healthy democracy. In today's world so much of what we need to consider when making decisions involves the evidence we get from scientific pursuits."
