#### **6.1. Dean's Report** - Lucy Lee

- Lucy thanked everyone for stepping up during the COVID-19 situation.
- The summer term will be fully online. The fall term will likely be online as well so if
  courses can be taught online, then faculty should plan accordingly. A task force has
  been implemented to look at those courses which cannot be held without a face to
  face component their findings will be presented within the next few days. Solutions
  will be presented to the Policy Emergency Group and announced university wide
  shortly. UFV continues to follow the guidelines of the Provincial Health Officers.
  Discussion followed.
- Going forward UFV is following the requested schedules set out by the Scheduling
  Office, however, changes can always be requested if need be. As a publicly funded
  university we abide by the provincial guidelines so are not in a position to pay extra to
  faculty and staff for preparation. In terms of peripherals needed, the university is
  coming up with solutions. If exams are requested to be held in person, it could happen
  in fall but is not possible for the summer.
- Lucy provided an update on positions. The Associate Dean position has been released;
   Math & Stats has postponed their full-time position and has now received an extra LTA to cover their needs; the Biology and SLUEC positions are still ongoing.
- The AAA Awards will be announced at the next Science Council meeting.
- Congratulations to Physics student, Annabelle Czihaly, who was selected as our representative at LIYSF for 2020. Since the 2020 LIYSF has now been postponed until next year, Annabelle will attend next year's event with our 2021 winner.
- Student Summer Research: As long as students can maintain the social distancing
  precautions they are able to do their research. The NSERC USRAs have been announced
  and are working with their supervisors on how they can perform their work throughout
  the summer. Lucy asked that faculty inform the Research Office of what they and their
  students are doing.
