6.1. Dean's Report - Michael Hitch

- Michael thanked everyone for all the work they have done over the year and expressed his gratitude for the warm welcome to the University over the year.
- Michael asked for input on how the Faculty of Science shapes the Faculty Council meetings in the future.
- The Chancellor's Installation will be on Thursday, May 9, 2024.
- Convocation is on June 11 13, 2024. The Faculty of Science will be part of the June 11 ceremony at 9:30 am. All are encouraged to attend.
- Both Agriculture and Geoscience are going through program redevelopment.
- Kyle Baillie, Liana Thompson, and Michael are working on a 1st year course for Science students designed to equip first-year university students with essential skills and strategies for success in a Sciences program. The course aims to bridge the gap between academic expectations and student readiness.
- There is a working group looking at the campus plan for the Chilliwack Campus. This
 will likely include the OneHealth concept focusing on animal health, human health,
 and environmental health. We are also moving ahead with creating a first-year
 Science timetable for CEP starting Fall 2024.
