- The first week of the term was busy, there was some confusion about getting into labs regarding the change of waitlisting for labs versus lectures. Would like to receive feedback from the departments regarding this change.
- Grad checks some students have been making appointments and the advisors ask that faculty encourage more students to come in.
- There have been approx. 58 BSc graduates each year the past 3 years and we expect significantly more graduates this year.
- Special Note: There is success amongst students that have only 3 years of school; some have gone on to other programs - Could there be a mechanism through Alumni to track the students that do not 'graduate' from UFV? Institutional Research could potentially filter on the students that have a high GPA and send out a survey.
- The Science Advice Centre makes notes of where students are going after they graduate and even the ones that don't graduate, a note can be made in the spreadsheet but there is no Institutional way to keep track.
