Edit an In-Progress Test

If a student begins a test but doesn't submit it you cannot grade it. This process shows you how to submit the test for you to grade it.



1. On the left hand menu click grade center then full grade center.



2. A test is in progress if you see a small pie chart in the place where the grade should be in the grade center.

3. First press refresh at the top of the left hand menu to ensure that the student hasn't submitted while you were in the grade center.
