



How to Export and Import Tests


You can export your tests to a blackboard file that you can later import to move tests from one course to another. This can also be done with Course Copy and ensuring Tests, Surveys, and Pools is checked to copy.



- 1. Go to Course Tools → Tests, Surveys and Pools
- 2. Click Tests









3. Choose the arrow next to the test you want to export and choose Export.

To import


Go to the shell you want to import the test into and go back to Course Tools →

2. Click Browse Local Files




3. Find the Exported Test and click Open




4. Press Submit
