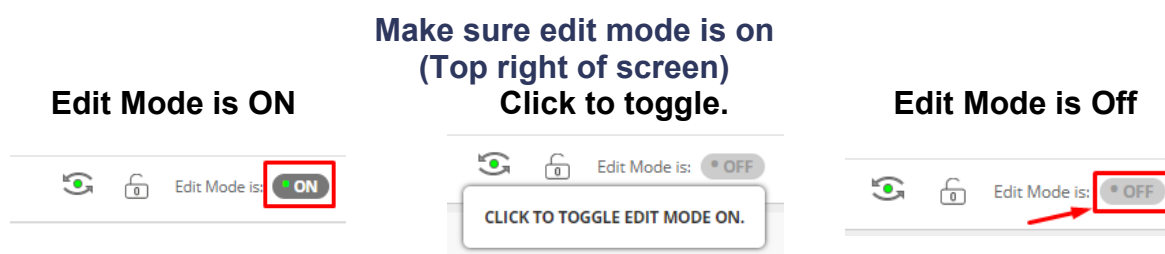
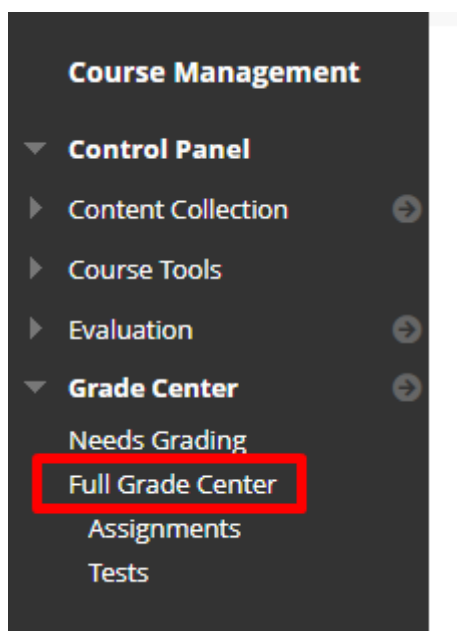


Grading Using a Rubric

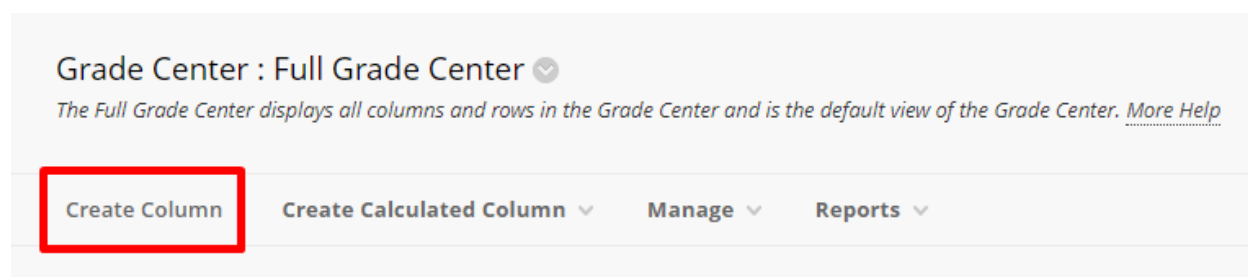
You can create a rubric in the grade center without having an assignment submission.



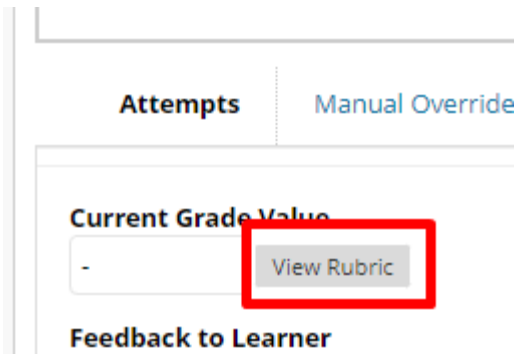
1. Go to the full grade center.



2. Click create column.

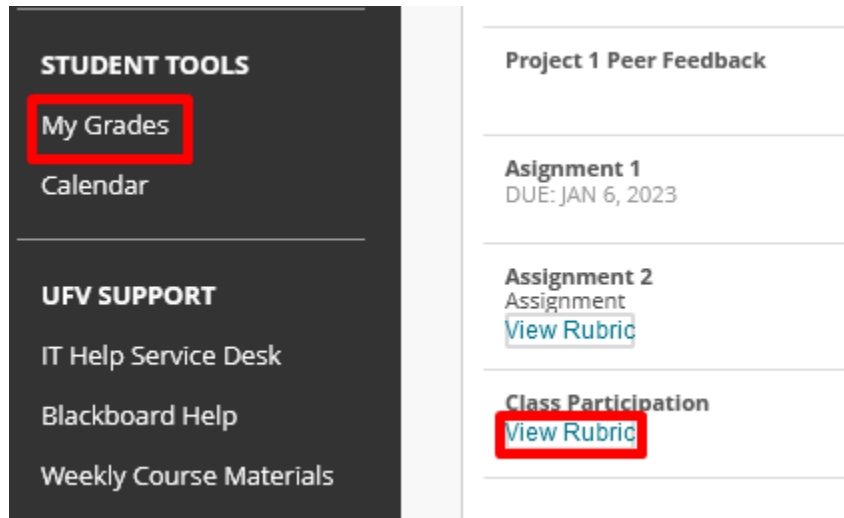
