

UFV COVID-19 OPERATIONS GUIDELINE

Student Study Space

Overview

This document is intended to provide guidance to UFV students who need to access a quiet space for individual study, with access to WIFI. Student study spaces have been made available at the following locations:

- Abbotsford campus in rooms A300, A305, and A315.
- Abbotsford campus: Common areas such as the Cascades Cafeteria and outside of the Spirit Bear Cafe.
- Chilliwack Canada Education Park, Building A: Common areas including the main foyer outside of the Spirit Bear Cafe.

Current Health Guidance Relating to Student Study Space

All students accessing the Student Study Space must agree to the following guidelines before entering the Student Study Space.

1. Students must complete a daily self-assessment. Refer to [UFV Operations Guideline: Self-Assessment](#) for further information.
2. Students must follow physical distancing as it is the most effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19. This means keeping a safe distance (6 feet/2 meters) between yourself and other people. While on campus it is important to adhere to the physical distancing guidelines and take all necessary precautions to minimize the risk of transmission of COVID-19.
3. Students must use [Non-medical masks/face coverings](#) at all times according to restrictions ordered by the Provincial Health Office. If accommodations are needed, refer to [UFV Operations Guideline: Higher Risk Populations](#).

Student Study Space Protocol

1. Student Study Space for quiet, individual study is located.
2. Student Study Space is for individual study only.
3. Students must follow guidelines for maintaining physical distance when accessing space. Refer to [UFV Operations Guideline: Physical Distancing Guideline](#).
4. Students must follow guidelines for sanitization cards when accessing space. [Refer to UFV Operations Guideline: Cleaning Protocols](#).
5. Student Study Space can be accessed by drop-in; booking space in advance is not required.
6. Risk & Safety Ambassadors frequently walk-by space to ensure guidelines are being followed. Students must follow the directions of the Risk & Safety Ambassadors.
