- ConnectED May 8th: This year's "teach, learn, transform" ConnectED conference will host a
 variety of sessions and an amazing keynote speaker, <u>Dr. Kevin Gannon</u>, author of *Radical Hope: A
 Teaching Manifesto*. The <u>Call for Proposals</u> is extended to April 5th micro teach, SoTL research,
 extended teaching experience, and Communities of Practice sessions will be offered. Registration
 will open on April 8th.

- SLG: One of the hidden gems of this university is the Support Learning Groups program. It is well
 documented in higher education research that the SLG's peer-to-peer teaching model plays a
 significant factor in student success. Annual SLG reports indicate that courses supported by SLG
 Leaders have an overall increase in mean and median GPA. Furthermore, the competencies and
 confidence that SLG Leaders themselves develop are a huge reciprocal benefit of this model. UFV's
 <u>SLG Program</u> is hiring new leaders for the 2024-25 academic year. Please encourage strong

4. BCAC's visit to India and FVI – Victoria Surtees

16 staff, non-teaching faculty, and faculty members from UFV all travelled to India with the aim of building capacity to foster internationalized and inclusive learning environments. How? By engaging in intercultural learning experiences to develop intercultural skills, build relationships, and generate action for inclusion. They prepared for this trip by engaging in 8 community learning sessions on topics of culture, engaging in local communities, understanding education systems in India, international student stories, navigating student-teacher expectations, supporting multilingual students, and managing difficult conversations.

During the tour, they experienced Northern India, the environment, food, and culture, all while touring the Taj Mahal, Golden Temple, Virasat-e-Khalsa, and life in Chandigarh. They learned about local education experiences and built connections by touring Fraser Valley India, Indian School of Business, Saint Bede's College, Vivek High School, and Learning Paths School.
