Teaching and Learning Report - Awneet Sivia

- Learning Exchange and K-16 Conversations: In collaboration with the Provost's Office and following a successful Education Summit in November with FV School Districts, Awneet and the TLC team launched the first of a series of webinars on February 13th that brought together UFV faculty and FV School District educators to discuss innovative pedagogies. There are a total of five Learning Exchange webinars scheduled around topics such as assessment, Indigenization, student-readiness, and Trades partnerships. The webinars are open to all. The two webinars so far have fostered productive conversations about how to bridge the gaps for students as they transition to post-secondary education at UFV.
- ConnectED May 8th: This year's "teach, learn, transform" ConnectED conference will host a variety
 of sessions and an amazing keynote speaker. The call for proposals opens March 4th with the
 following presentation options micro teach, SoTL research, extended teaching experience, and
 Communities of Practice sessions. Visit the <u>Teaching and Learning website</u>.
- Staffing: The TLC team has posted and is conducting interviews for an Events Coordinator,
 following the departure of Kayla Jones, and two Learning Designers to assist with the Learning
 Management System Review. We have also hired Leanne Joe as the new, 0.6FTE Indigenous
 Curriculum Developer. Leanne's focus will be on supporting the Indigenization of curriculum and
 she works Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Her office is in G110.
- Learning Environment Guidelines: The Learning Environments Advisory Group met in January in G113 (the demo classroom across from the TLC) to showcase how the classroom can facilitate technology integration and hybrid/hyflex formats. One outcome of that demonstration session (led by TLC Learning Designer Soowook Kim) was the need to develop guidelines for UFV classrooms based on modality. Awneet, Brian Wilkinson, and Kristi Wood are developing a resource that lists the types of technology tools needed for the five modalities described in the academic calendar (OLO, OLM, HYB, HYF, and TRD). From this resource, we plan to generate a set of guidelines for effective teaching and learning environments at UFV. These guidelines will be shared with TLAC in the fall of 2024.
- FLEx: The TLC Specialists are once again engaged in the FLEx program where they partner with faculty to observe classes and discuss strategies to support learning and push practice forward.
 Claire Hay and Luisa Giles presented a session about their partnership and learning experiences from the FLEx program at the VCC Teaching Symposium on February 29th.
- Tech Talk Forum: On January 31, 2024, Michelle Johnson facilitated The Fifth Annual Tech Talk to look back on the impacts of AI and ChatGPT over the past year. Attendees learned about developments in Teaching and Learning, student experiences, and celebrated faculty ingenuity. The event brought together over 40 participants from various disciplines to discuss its impact, challenges, and possibilities at UFV. Sandra Smith from the Academic Support Centre addressed student concerns and the development of support systems for AI tools. Dr. Anna Griffith, Assistant Professor in the School of Creative Arts, focused on experiential learning and discussed her work at

the intersection of creativity, sustainability, and EDI, including her current project on Regenerative Education featured on her podcast Creative Praxis.

- Blanket Exercise at Provost Cabinet: Lorna Andrews supported the facilitation of the Blanket Exercise with members of Provost's Cabinet on Monday, March 4th at the Gathering Place. The facilitators took the members through a variety of experiences and Lorna closed with the Sharing Circle.
