Teaching and Learning Report - Awneet Sivia

- Launch Program for New Faculty: Michelle Johnson and Claire Hay are once again facilitating the
 Launch Program for a record 31 new faculty who are participating, beginning on October 4th. The
 program is taught over two semesters (18 two-hour sessions), offered in hybrid format, and
 participants are eligible to earn a badge as it is now recognized as a microcredential through
 CanCred. The program weaves together 'big picture' educational concepts and strategies with
 practical approaches including instructional methods, curriculum development, and assessment
 practices.
- Changemaker TIPP Fund: Dr. Anna Griffith, Curriculum Developer (Changemaker Education/ILOs) is leading the newly developed Teaching Inquiries into Pedagogical Practices (TIPP) in Changemaking fund. We can fund up to 10 faculty for the Winter 2025 semester. The deadline for the application is October 31, 2024. - LMS Project Update: D2L's Brightspace is the new LMS for UFV. We are beyond thrilled to have selected the best LMS to support our focus as a teaching intensive institution. The TLC and ITS teams are busy working on preparations to pilot Brightspace with a small group of faculty in Winter 2025, followed by a larger pilot group for Summer 2025. The go-live date is August 25, 2025, with all Fall 2025 courses set up in Brightspace. - A Guide for Learning: Part A Developing Learning Outcomes: Claire Hay has created the second publication out of the TLC with this new guidebook, available digitally at https://ufv.ca/teaching-and-learning/teaching-strategies/curriculum-development/. The guidebook will be used by UEC, Faculty Curriculum Committees, Program Development and Quality Assurance, and any member of UFV who is developing curriculum and learning outcomes. The Guide for Learning replaces the Learning Outcomes Guide and brings curriculum development well into the 21st century with contemporary approaches to creating a curriculum that aligns with UFV's ILOs and institutional priorities.
