
Save a Portfolio




Save and View a Blackboard Portfolio

This allows you to download and save a portfolio you created in Blackboard and view it in a web browser. It is not possible to transfer your blackboard portfolio directly into Brightspace.

- 1. Log into myClass: https://ufv.ca/myclass/
- 2. In the left side menu, click on Tools, and click on Portfolios




3. In My Portfolios, select the portfolio you would like to save, and click on **More**. Then select **Download**.



4. In the new window that appears, click on Click to download Portfolio.

You may be able to choose the destination of your file and click Save; otherwise it will be saved in your downloads folder. It takes a few minutes, so be patient!




Once it is downloaded, you can close the Download pop-up window by clicking on the x or anywhere outside the window.

- 5. Your portfolio has been downloaded as a .zip file. To view your Portfolio, you have to first extract all the content of that zip file:
 - On a Windows device, open file explorer




 Right-click on the PortfolioDownload.zip file and choose Extract All



• On a mac computer, double click the **PortfolioDownload.zip** file in your **Finder** App.The unzipped files will appear in a new folder with the same name, located in the same location as the .zip file

- 6. To open and view your portfolio:
 - Click on the folder to open it up and see what files are inside.
 - Double click on the index.html file. Your portfolio will open in a web browser.



Check that everything is accessible, and that all the documents attached can be opened properly.
