## Notes and Terms

Historical numbers in this year's Factbook may differ slightly from previous Factbooks due to (i) changes in data definitions or (ii) retroactive changes made to historical records.

**Age:** As of September 30th of the Fiscal Year.

**Continuing Education (CE):** Non-academic and non-trades programs or courses.

**Credential "None":** A program that does not grant a UFV credential.

**Domestic/International:** If a student pays international fees for part, or all, of a given Fiscal Year, they are counted as International in that Fiscal Year.

**Fiscal Year:** Unless otherwise stated, all data is for Fiscal Year, which runs from April 1 to March 31 of the following Calendar Year.

**FTE:** Full Time Equivalent student. This is calculated as recognized credits (or hours) divided by the appropriate program divisor. FTEs represent UFV's instructional activity converted to represent the number of students carrying a course load corresponding to normal progression in their program. To count for FTE purposes, a student course registration must have passed the stable enrolment date and be considered instructional activity as defined by the Ministry.

**Full Time/Part Time (FT/PT):** A student is Full Time in a Fiscal Year if the student generates at least 0.6 of an FTE; a student with less than 0.6 but greater than zero FTEs, is Part Time.

**Graduate:** A student who graduates from a UFV program. A student may be granted multiple credentials in a given year. Students graduate once a year in June and these graduates are attributed to the previous Fiscal Year. For example, June 2019 graduates are attributed to Fiscal Year 2018-19.

**Headcount:** A student is included in Headcount if the student generates positive FTEs.

**Indigenous Student, Self-Declared:** Students can self-declare as being Indigenous while studying at UFV. UFV does not require students to declare their status. On their application form, students may elect to self-declare as Aboriginal, First nations, Métis, or Inuit.

**New to UFV:** A student is New to UFV when the student first generates a positive FTE at UFV in a non-CE term. New to UFV is set only once for each student.

**Registration:** A single student enrolment in a course that generates any FTEs.

**Returning to UFV Student:** A student is Returning to UFV if the student has previously generated FTEs at UFV, in a non-CE term.

**Unduplicated Headcount:** Each student is counted only once; a student is not counted as a member of multiple groups.

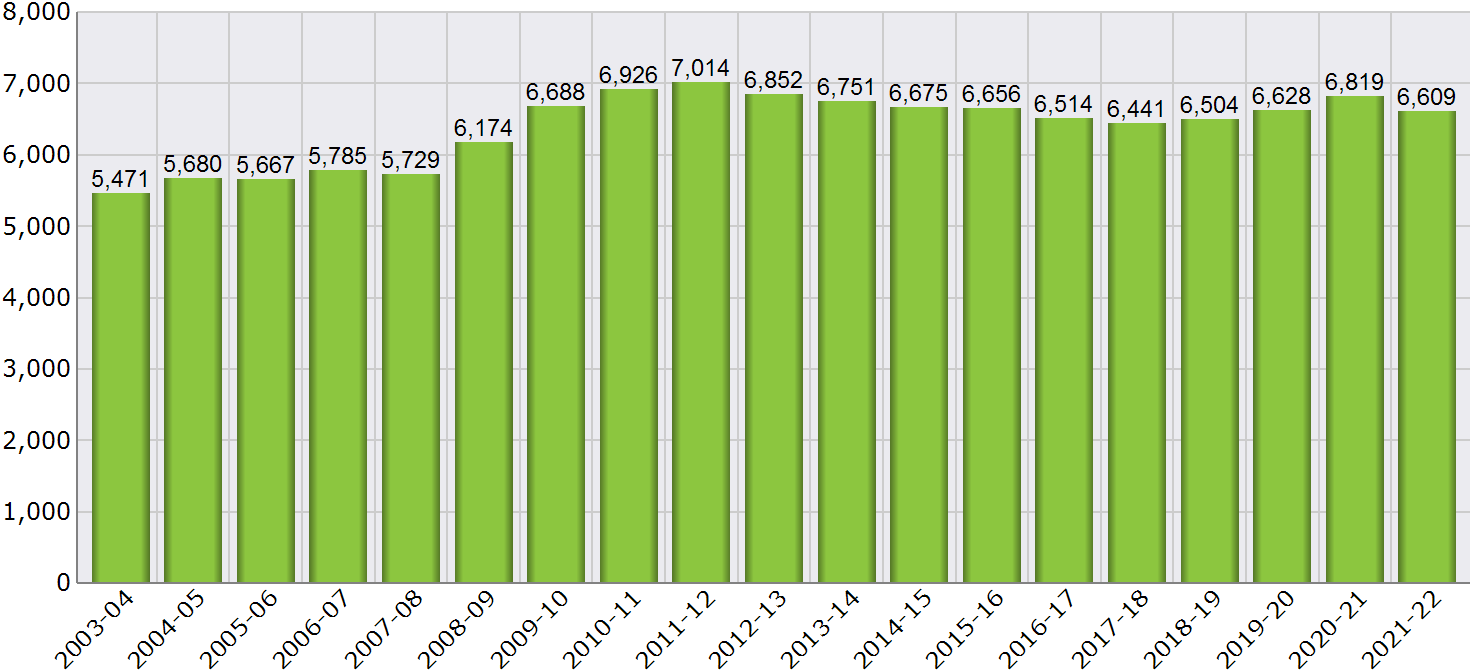

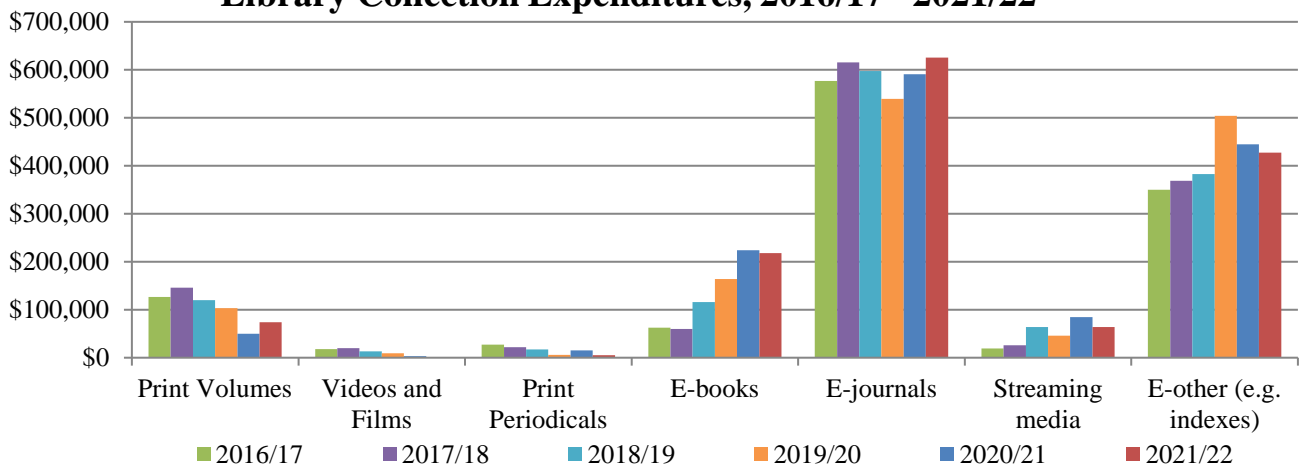

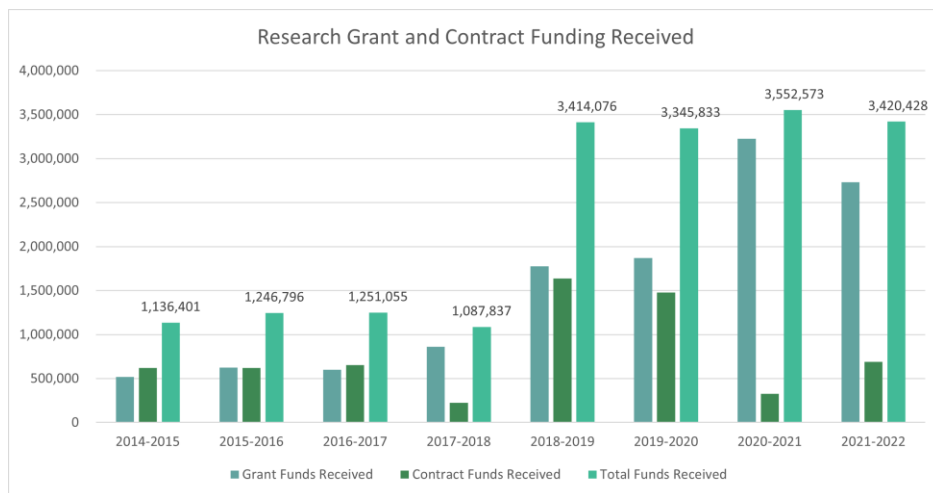

## **Section 9: Research and Graduate Studies**

Research is a highly valued scholarly activity that is integrated with teaching and provides significant opportunities for UFV to offer applied learning opportunities for students as research assistants, and the development of community engaged partnerships. Research enables faculty to remain at the cutting edge of their discipline, which they can then bring to the classroom and use as mentorship opportunities with small groups of students. Partnerships with industry, government, and community organizations enable researchers to develop applied solutions to current challenges that lead to the creation of significant economic and social value for the region. Research this past year has led to applied agriculture innovation, improved understanding of the role of organized sport programs in crime reduction, engagement with community groups to address racism, advances in science, and movement towards fuller reconciliation with First Nation communities, plus many other research outcomes.

There are twelve research institutes, centres and labs. These hubs of collaborative research facilitate interdisciplinary approaches to research questions, the pooling of resources, and the building of capacity that supports the addition of student research assistants, post-doctoral researchers, coordinators, and research associates. Overall, they have made significant contributions to the total value of external funding, the increased numbers of paid student research assistants, and increased community engagement.

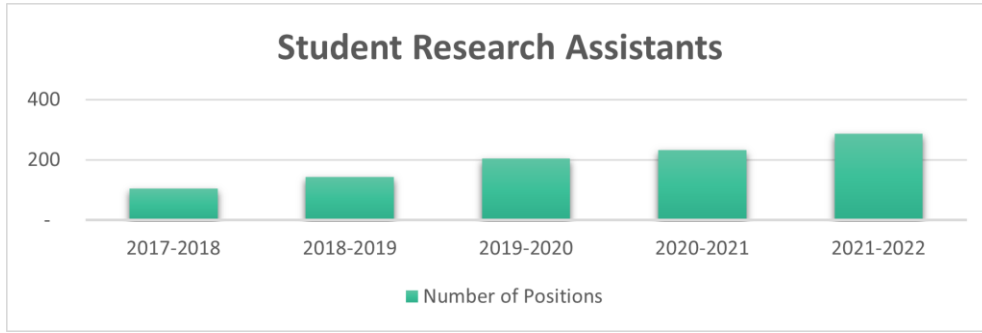

There were 23% more paid student research assistants hired through the Research Office this past year, for a total of 363 student positions, comprised of 287 funded project contracts and an additional 76 research assistant positions supported by the Career Centre’s Work Study Program. Those 363 positions were valued at \$419,685 from a combination of internal and external funding sources. See Table 2.

In addition, the Research Office provided 61 student research awards for Student Research Day, Undergraduate Research Excellence Awards, NSERC USRA, and conference travel awards totaling another \$95,545.

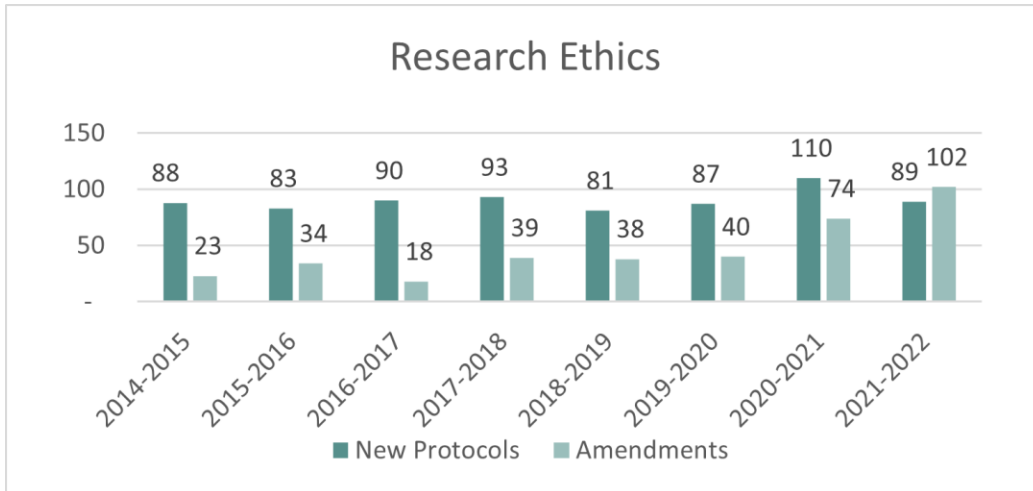

UFV offered 155 research courses in the past year and enrollment in these courses included 2,069 students. Tracking these enrollments is important as it demonstrates the number of students that are gaining insight into research methods, and a greater understanding of research processes which they can then use in their future careers.

The added number and value of research projects has also increased the administrative workload within the Research Office. For example, the Human Research Ethics Board and Compliance Officer had to administer 89 new research protocols and 102 amendments, which follows the upward pattern of the previous seven years (see Table 3).

UFV proudly conferred 73 graduate level credentials in 2021-2022, including 25 Master of Social Work degrees. 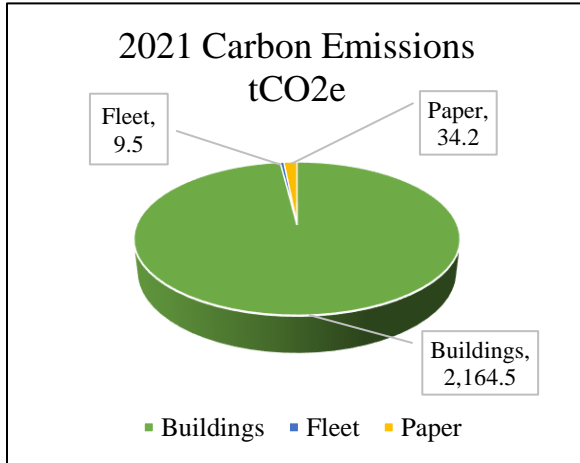


Figure 1: 2021 Carbon emissions by source.

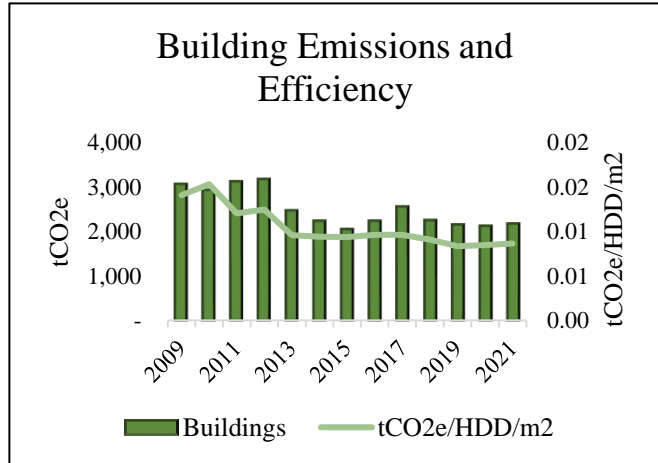


Figure 2: Building emissions per year, and normalized emissions for space and weather fluctuations.
